Methodological remarks, concepts, definitions

The scope of health services is included in the Act LXXXIII of 1997 on the benefits of the compulsory health insurance and the Government Order 217/1997 (XII.1.) regulating the implementation of this act.

This chapter presents the data of those concluded financing contract.

Financing contract: is concluded between the financing institute (NHIFA, Regional Offices of the National Health Insurance Fund) and the service provider for health service.

To define the indicators regarding financed services (per services, station), we count their average number per month.

Chapter 7.1. to 7.8.5. are containing date of service providers which concluded financing contract with NHIFA relating to the performance and financing of the period from 1 January to 31 December.

Dental care

<u>Source of data</u>: performance data of the dental care services that are forwarded to the National Health Insurance Funds Administration.

The annual data include the corrections made until the end of the year (subsequent account because lack of data or mistake in the report, data correction, supplement of unprocessed data because of technical, reasons, correction after audit), modifying the respective month.

Number of cases: one case is the appearance of one patient within a calendar day regardless of the number of services provided for him/her.

Number of interventions: number of services provided for the patient during one appearance.

Financial support as entrepreneurial for basic care: Government Decree No. 229/2001. (XII. 5.) on the financial support of general practitioners, family paediatricians and dentists providing basic cares, which made it possible for the providers to claim financial assistance at buying equipment and real estates for the use of providing services, was repealed on 1 January 2006. – Decree No. 329/2005. (XII. 29.) – however the rules of the Government Decree above should be still applied for valid and updated contract made before 2006. New equipment support being lunched in 2011 (Government Decree No. 216/2001. (X. 19.) on Purchasing Hungarian medical products).
