Revenues and expenses of the Health Insurance Fund

Source of data: - Department of Financial and Economic of NIHIFM, and Department of Health Insurance Fund

The decline in expenditures and incomes of operating costs in 2016 is due to: the impact of the institutional integration on budget (as specified in governmental decision 1744/2014 (XII.15) and 2018/2015 (XII.29).

Pension benefit: up to 2006 pension benefit of disabled persons (category III) under the age-limit, which was financed by the Health Insurance Fund. In 2008 transmitted cash to the Pension Fund for covering disability pension. From 2012 disability, rehabilitation benefits.

GDP: Gross Domestic Product.

Health care price index: in order to achieve long-term comparability and learn the true trends of the expenditures of health care, a health price index is calculated since 1987 by the Ministry of Health and from 2006 on by the National Institute of Strategic Health Research (NISHR), from 2011 on by National Institute for Quality- and Organizational Development in Healthcare and Medicines. The calculation of this index is based on the OSAP (National Statistical Survey Programme) No. 1477 statistical data collection.

Consumer price index: the (average) price changes of products and services purchased by the households (population) for their own use during a period of time. The consumer price index indicates the rate of inflation ("depreciation"). The price changes are measured by monitoring a consumer basket compiled of expediently selected products and services from month to month.
